The City Council meeting was called to order by Mayor Hamm followed by a request for roll call. Present were Alderpersons Jenkins, Bridick, Vrabec, Hampsey, Foley, Riskovsky, Haynes and Gardner. Absent: None.

All present recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

It was moved by Alderman Bridick, seconded by Alderman Haynes, to approve the minutes of the regular meeting held on February 23, 2016. Voice vote as follows: eight (8) ayes; no nays. Absent: None. Motion carried.

It was moved by Alderman Vrabec, seconded by Alderman Bridick, to approve the presentation of Claims. Voice vote as follows: eight (8) ayes; no nays. Absent: None. Motion carried.

Police Chief Burns reported that the new hire had passed all testing and is slated to start mid-April. He also stated that he will finalize bids for new police vehicles within the next 60 days. Fire Chief Bridick reported that they department was on flood water standby with the St. Louis City and County. Director of Public Works Treadway provided update on rent demos. He stated that there were 11 demos and that the grounds had been leveled off with sand and dirt. There were no reports from Health Inspector Shelby and Building Inspector Broadway, who was absent. 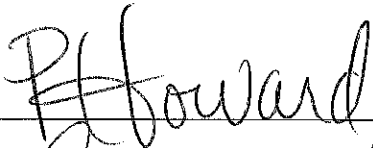
