

City Council Meeting
May 17, 2016
Minutes

The City Council meeting was called to order followed by a request for roll call. Present were Alderpersons Jenkins, Bridick, Foley, Riskovsky, Hampsey, Vrabec, and Haynes. Absent: Gardner.

All present recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

It was moved by Alderman Bridick, seconded by Alderman Haynes to appoint Alderman Vrabec as Mayor Pro Tem in the absence of Mayor Hamm. Voice vote as follows: six (6) ayes; no nays; one absent. Motion carried.

It was moved by Alderman Bridick, seconded by Alderman Hampsey, to approve the minutes of the regular meeting held on May 3, 2016. Voice vote as follows: six (6) ayes; no nays. Absent: one. Motion carried.

It was moved by Alderman Foley, seconded by Alderman Hampsey, to approve the presentation of Claims. Voice vote as follows: six (6) ayes; no nays. Absent: one. Motion carried.

It was moved by Alderman Foley, seconded by Alderman Bridick, to approve Claims as presented. Roll call vote as follows: Ayes: Jenkins, Bridick, Foley, Riskovsky, Hampsey and Haynes. Nays: none. Motion carried.

It was moved by Alderman Foley, seconded by Alderman Haynes, to approve the Comptroller's Report as presented. Voice vote as follows: six (6) ayes; no nays; one (1) absent. Motion carried.

It was moved by Alderman Hampsey, seconded by Alderman Bridick to appoint Gordon Freeman to the library board. Voice vote as follows: six (6) ayes; no nays; one (1) absent. Motion carried.

Alderman Gardner arrived at 6:32 pm.

At this time, Milton Dixon presented the council with a flyer regarding the annual car show. This event will be held at the 3rd Street Baseball Field on July 19th, 2016 from 1-3pm. It was moved by Alderman Hampsey, seconded by Alderman Jenkins to approve this event. Voice vote as follows: seven (7) ayes; no nays; none absent. Motion carried.

Director of Public Works addressed the council and let them know that the new trash truck has been delivered and was put in service on Monday, May 16, 2016. The truck has worked awesome and will allow the trash route to go down to two days a week in the near future. Alderman Hampsey asked about complaints because trash cans are being placed in the middle of the street. Treadway stated that the cans will need to be 3-4 feet from the curb but won't be in the middle of the street. Hampsey stated that this will take a 3 lane street down to a 1 lane street.

Treadway stated that this will not be an issue as there will be a breaking in period on the part of the residents and the workers.

It was moved by Alderman Hampsey, seconded by Alderman Bridick to accept reports of Department Officers. Voice vote as follows: seven (7) ayes; no nays; none absent. Motion carried.

It was moved by Alderman Foley, seconded by Alderman Bridick to approve Arlando Ferrell to purchase 1114 Reynolds in the amount of \$500 as no bids were received when this was placed up for surplus property bid. Roll call vote as follows: Ayes: Jenkins, Bridick, Foley, Riskovsky, Hampsey, Gardner and Haynes. Nays: none. Motion carried.

At this time Alderman Gardner thanked Alderman Riskovsky for purchasing all new jerseys for the Khoury League baseball team.



Roll call vote as follows: Ayes: Jenkins, Bridick, Foley, Riskovsky, Hampsey, Gardner and Haynes. Nays: none. Motion carried.

There being no further business, it was moved by Alderman Haynes, seconded by Alderman Gardner to the adjourn meeting. Voice vote as follows: seven (7) ayes; no nays; none absent. Motion carried.
