

Madison City Council
July 23, 2019
Minutes

The City Council meeting was called to order by Mayor Hamm at 6:00 p.m. followed by a request for roll call. Present were Alderpersons Bridick, Vrabec, Hampsey, Crochrell, Riskovsky, Gardner and Haynes. Absent: Jenkins.

All present recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

It was moved by Alderman Bridick, seconded by Alderman Riskovsky, to approve the minutes of the regular meeting held on July 9, 2019. Voice vote as follows: seven (7) ayes; no nays. Absent: One. Motion carried.

It was moved by Alderman Vrabec, seconded by Alderman Bridick, to approve the Presentation of the Comptroller's Report as submitted and that bills be allowed as drawn on the treasury and presented to the Council, unless there are any questions of the Summary Expenses for the period of July 10, 2019 through July 23, 2019 in the amount of \$234,580.76. The Comptroller's Report was accepted as presented and placed on file. Roll call vote as follows: Ayes: Bridick, Vrabec, Hampsey, Crochrell, Riskovsky, Haynes and Gardner. Nays: None. Absent: Jenkins. Motion carried.

There were no appointments by Mayor Hamm and no members of the public addressing the Council.

Chief Gailius announced that the City will host its 1st Annual National Night Out. More information will be forthcoming. Police Commissioner Turner reported that the Police Board of Commissioners had adopted mandatory rules and regulations that are now posted at City Hall. There being no other reports, it was moved by Alderman Haynes, seconded by Alderman Riskovsky to accept the reports of the department officers. Voice vote as follows: seven (7) ayes; no nays. Absent: One. Motion carried.

It was moved by Alderman Vrabec, seconded by Alderman Bridick, to suspend Rule 38 of Ordinance #549. Voice vote as follows: seven (7) ayes; no nays. Absent: One. Motion carried.

It was moved by Alderman Vrabec, seconded by Alderman Bridick, to approve "Ordinance #1833 Appropriating Funds for all Corporate Purposes for the City of Madison, Illinois, for the Fiscal Year Beginning May 1, 2019 and Ending April 30, 2020." Roll call vote as follows: Ayes: Bridick, Vrabec, Hampsey, Crochrell, Riskovsky, Haynes and Gardner. Nays: None. Absent: Jenkins. Motion carried.

It was moved by Alderman Vrabec, seconded by Alderman Bridick, to approve the motion to purchase a table of eight (8) and a full-page ad for the 3rd Annual NAACP Freedom Fund Banquet scheduled for September 21, 2019 for a total of \$550.00. Roll call vote as follows: Ayes: Bridick, Vrabec, Hampsey, Crochrell, Riskovsky, Haynes and Gardner. Nays: None. Absent: Jenkins. Motion carried.

At the request of Alderman Crochrell, Agenda Item #6, for support of a mentoring program, was removed from the Agenda.

It was moved by Alderman Bridick, seconded by Alderman Hampsey, to approve a proposal for Grouting Structures in the amount of \$7,750.00 from Visu-Sewer. Roll call vote as follows: Ayes: Bridick, Vrabec, Hampsey, Crochrell, Riskovsky, Haynes and Gardner. Nays: None. Absent: Jenkins. Motion carried.

There was no attorney presentation of petitions, resolutions and ordinances, and no attorney report.

The Street Department have 12 demos upcoming in the City.

It was brought to the attention of the Council that there was an ordinance on Chapter 130.06 in place governing curfews in the City of Madison. There is a curfew of midnights on the weekend and 10:00 p.m. during the week. Youth in the City of Madison may be out later during the week if accompanied by parental or adult supervision over the age of 21. It was stated that the curfew issue is more of a burden on the Police Department handling enforcement.

There being no executive session or other business to come before the Council, it was moved by Alderman Crochrell, seconded by Alderman Riskovsky, to adjourn the meeting at 6:15 p.m. Voice vote as follows: seven (7) ayes; no nays. Absent: One. Motion carried.
