

Madison City Council  
Minutes  
October 13, 2020

The City Council meeting was called to order by Mayor John Hamm at 6:00 p.m., followed by a request for roll call. Present were Alderpersons Jenkins, Bridick, Vrabec, Hampsey, Crochrell, Riskovsky, Haynes and Gardner. Absent: None.

All present recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

It was moved by Alderman Haynes, seconded by Alderman Riskovsky, to approve the minutes of the regular Council meeting held on September 28, 2020. Voice vote as follows: eight (8) ayes; no nays. Absent: None. Motion carried.

It was moved by Alderman Vrabec, seconded by Alderperson Haynes, to approve the presentation of the Comptroller's Report as submitted and that bills be allowed as drawn on the treasury and presented to the Council, unless there are any questions of the Summary of Expenses for the period of September 28, 2020 through October 13, 2020 in the amount of \$131,204.95. The Comptroller's Report was accepted as presented, to be placed on file. Roll call vote as follows: Ayes: Jenkins, Bridick, Vrabec, Hampsey, Crochrell, Riskovsky, Haynes and Gardner. Nays: None. Absent: None. Motion carried.

There were no appointments by Mayor Hamm and no members of the public wanting to address the Council.

Police Commissioner Donald Turner reported that they have five applicants for the position of Lateral Policeman at the Police Department. He further stated that orientation will begin on Saturday. Alderman Haynes asked if there were any minorities among the recruits. There being no other reports to come before the Council, it was moved by Alderman Riskovsky, seconded by Alderman Haynes, to accept the reports of Department Officers. Voice vote as follows: eight (8) ayes; no nays. Absent: None. Motion carried.

It was moved by Alderman Vrabec, seconded by Alderman Hampsey, to concur with Juneau's bid results for #1 Caine Drive parking lot project awarding the lowest bid to Rickey Brothers, Inc. in the amount of \$54,585.00. Roll call vote as follows: Ayes: Jenkins, Bridick, Vrabec, Hampsey, Crochrell, Riskovsky, Haynes and Gardner. Nays: None. Absent: None. Motion carried.

It was moved by Alderman Vrabec, seconded by Alderman Hampsey, to open bids for the sale of #5 Caine (Diamond Plating). Voice vote as follows: eight (8) ayes; no nays. Absent: None. Motion carried.

Having received only one bid, it was moved by Alderman Vrabec, seconded by Alderman Hampsey, to approve the winning bid from Illinois American Water in the amount of \$800,000.00 for the property located at #5 Caine Drive (Diamond Plating). Roll call vote as follows: Ayes: Jenkins, Bridick, Vrabec, Hampsey, Crochrell, Riskovsky, Haynes and Gardner. Nays: None. Absent: None. Motion carried.

It was moved by Alderman Vrabec, seconded by Alderman Bridick, to open bids for the sale of property located at 304-308 Madison Avenue (Old Farm Fresh lot). Voice vote as follows: eight (8) ayes; no nays. Absent: None. Motion carried.


Having received only one bid, it was moved by alderman Vrabec, seconded by Alderman Bridick, to approve the winning bid I & I Madison Mart Corporation in the amount of \$450,000.00 for property located at 304-308 Madison Avenue. Roll call vote as follows: Ayes: Jenkins, Bridick, Vrabec, Hampsey, Crochrell, Riskovsky, Haynes and Gardner. Nays: None. Absent: None. Motion carried.

It was unanimously approved to allow request from Terra Wiggins to use the Farm Fresh side lot for a home going fundraiser for her nephew. Voice vote as follows: eight (8) ayes; no nays. Absent: None. Motion carried.

Mayor Hamm updated the Council on the closing of Race Street. There being no executive session of no other business to come before the council, it was moved by Alderman Crochrell, seconded by Alderman Riskovsky to adjourned to meeting. Voice vote as follows: eight (8) ayes; no nays. Absent: None. Motion carried.

The next Council meeting will be held on Monday, October 26, 2020.


