

Madison City Council  
Minutes  
December 21, 2020

The City Council meeting was called to order by Mayor John Hamm at 6:00 p.m., followed by a request for roll call. Present were Alderpersons Jenkins, Bridick, Vrabec, Hampsey, Crochrell, Riskovsky, Haynes and Gardner. Absent: None.

All present recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

It was moved by Alderman Haynes, seconded by Alderman Riskovsky, to approve the minutes of the regular Council meeting held on December 7, 2020. Voice vote as follows: eight (8) ayes; no nays. Absent: None. Motion carried.

It was moved by Alderman Vrabec, seconded by Alderperson Bridick, to approve the presentation of the Comptroller's Report as submitted and that bills be allowed as drawn on the treasury and presented to the Council, unless there were any questions of the Summary of Expenses for the period of December 7, 2020 through December 23, 2020 in the amount of \$894,127.70. The Comptroller's Report was accepted as presented, to be placed on file. Roll call vote as follows: Ayes: Jenkins, Bridick, Vrabec, Hampsey, Crochrell, Riskovsky, Haynes and Gardner. Nays: None. Absent: None. Motion carried.

There were no appointments by Mayor Hamm and no members of the public wanting to address the Council.

There being no reports to come before the Council, it was moved by Alderman Riskovsky, seconded by Alderman Haynes, to accept the reports of Department Officers. Voice vote as follows: eight (8) ayes; no nays. Absent: None. Motion carried.

It was moved by Alderman Vrabec, seconded by Alderman Bridick, to open the bids for the sale of 2015 Skeen Street. Voice vote as follows: eight (8) ayes; no nays. Absent: None. Motion carried.

It was moved by Alderman Haynes, seconded by Alderman Vrabec, to approve and award the winning bid for 2015 Skeen Street to Ed Levy in the amount of \$1,250.00. Roll call vote as follows: Ayes: Jenkins, Bridick, Vrabec, Hampsey, Crochrell, Riskovsky, Haynes and Gardner. Nays: None. Absent: None. Motion carried.

It was moved by Alderman Vrabec, seconded by Alderman Bridick, to approve the agreement for engineering services for 2021 with Juneau & Associates. Roll call vote as follows: Ayes: Jenkins, Bridick, Vrabec, Hampsey, Crochrell, Riskovsky, Haynes and Gardner. Nays: None. Absent: None. Motion carried.

It was moved by Alderman Vrabec, seconded by Alderman Crochrell, to approve the J. F. Electric quote for heating system at City Hall/Police Department for a total of \$8,930.00. Roll call vote as follows: Ayes: Jenkins, Bridick, Vrabec, Hampsey, Crochrell, Riskovsky, Haynes and Gardner. Nays: None. Absent: None. Motion carried.

It was moved by Alderman Vrabec, seconded by Alderman Bridick, to approve Bryder Electric for electric heating system kits for City Hall/Police Department for a total of \$4,074.00. Roll call vote as follows: Ayes: Jenkins, Bridick, Vrabec, Hampsey, Crochrell, Riskovsky, Haynes and Gardner. Nays: None. Absent: None. Motion carried.

It was moved by Alderman Haynes, seconded by Alderman Riskovsky, to approve Sexual Harassment training for all employees. Roll call vote as follows: Ayes: Jenkins, Bridick, Vrabec, Hampsey, Crochrell, Riskovsky, Haynes and Gardner. Nays: None. Absent: None. Motion carried.

There were no attorney presentations of petitions, resolutions and ordinances, and no attorney report.

Mayor Hamm updated the Council on the lots that were given to Mr. Bishop for the building of the new houses in Madison.

Alderman Crochrell asked about the \$400.00 fees from the police department when towed by the City. Mayor Hamm explained that it was an administrative fee allowed by the state statute for the State of Illinois and that these were state statute fee done by Ordinance in 2016. Officer Pinero stated that there had been 126 tows (70 were \$400.00 administrative fees, 62 non-resident charges and eight citizens who were under criminal charges). It was moved by Alderman Crochrell to rescind the motion to lower fees from \$400.00. Motion was tabled to be put on the agenda for another meeting.

It was moved by Alderman Bridick, seconded by Alderman Riskovsky, to approve the purchase of a bucket from John Deere for a total of \$8,000.00. Roll call vote as follows: Ayes: Jenkins, Bridick, Vrabec, Hampsey, Crochrell, Riskovsky, Haynes and Gardner. Nays: None. Absent: None. Motion carried.

It was moved by Alderman Bridick, seconded by Alderman Vrabec, to approve quote from Baxmeyer to clean section next to CSI on Eagle Park Road with the cost to be passed on to CSI. Roll call vote as follows: Ayes: Jenkins, Bridick, Vrabec, Hampsey, Crochrell, Riskovsky, Haynes and Gardner. Nays: None. Absent: None. Motion carried.

It was moved by Alderman Vrabec, seconded by Alderman Hampsey, to put letter on file concerning the required NBIS inspections. Voice vote as follows: eight (8) ayes; no nays. Absent: None. Motion carried.

There being no executive session of no other business to come before the council, it was moved by Alderman Crochrell, seconded by Alderman Riskovsky to adjourned to meeting. Voice vote as follows: eight (8) ayes; no nays. Absent: None. Motion carried.
