

Madison City Council
January 8, 2019
Minutes

The City Council meeting was called to order by Mayor Hamm at 6:30 p.m. followed by a request for roll call. Present were Alderpersons Jenkins, Bridick, Vrabec, Hampsey, Glasper, Riskovsky, Gardner and Haynes. Absent: None.

All present recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

It was moved by Alderman Bridick, seconded by Alderman Riskovsky, to approve the minutes of the regular meeting held on December 26, 2018. Voice vote as follows: eight (8) ayes; no nays. Absent: None. Motion carried.

It was moved by Alderman Vrabec, seconded by Alderman Bridick, to approve the presentation of Claims. Voice vote as follows: eight (8) ayes; no nays. Absent: None. Motion carried.

It was moved by Alderman Vrabec, seconded by Alderman Bridick that bills be allowed as drawn on the treasury as presented, unless there are any questions of the Comptroller, from 12/27/2018 through 01/08/2019, in the amount of \$287,276.37. Roll call vote as follows: Ayes: Jenkins, Bridick, Vrabec, Glasper, Riskovsky, Gardner and Haynes. Nays: None. Absent: None. Motion carried.

It was moved by Alderman Vrabec, seconded by Alderman Bridick that the Comptroller's report for December 27, 2018 through January 8, 2019 be accepted as presented and placed on file unless there are questions for the Comptroller. Voice vote as follows: eight (8) ayes; no nays. Absent: None. Motion carried.

It was moved by Alderman Bridick, with regrets, seconded by Alderman Vrabec, to accept the recommendation of Chief Pinero to appoint Adam Heuser to full-time probationary patrolman effective within the next two weeks pending his resignation from current employment. Voice vote as follows: eight (8) ayes; no nays. Absent: None. Motion carried.

Member of the public, county board member Gussie Glasper addressed the council and public stating that if she could be of any assistance to please contact her.

There being no report of the department officers, it was moved by Alderman Haynes, seconded by Alderman Hampsey, to accept the status of no reports of the department officers. Voice vote as follows: eight (8) ayes; no nays. Absent: None. Motion carried.

There were no reports of the committees.

Due to the absence of Attorney John Papa, there were no attorney presentation of petitions, resolutions and ordinances and no attorney report.

There was no miscellaneous business.

Mayor Hamm provided an update on the recycle program. He stated that will continue with Republic to keep the program going at a cost of approximately \$200.00 per month. Mayor informed the Council that he had completed a demo on Klein for the City of Venice. He also reported that the City is preparing for the upcoming snow season and everything was in order with the Street Department.
