A charge of \$10.00 to cover the cost of postage and handling is required for those contractors requesting plans and specifications be mailed to them. Plans, specifications and contract documents are also available for examination at Southern Illinois Builders in O'Fallon, Illinois.

No bidder may withdraw his bid within ninety (90) days of the scheduled time of closing bids.

The successful bidder will be required to execute and present performance and payment bonds in a sum equal to the full amount of the contract. Bids must be for the contract as a whole.

All applicable laws, ordinances, and rules and regulations of all authorities having jurisdiction over construction of the project shall apply to this contract.

The successful bidder will be required to agree that not less than the prevailing rate of wages as determined by the Secretary of Labor and made a part of these contract documents shall be paid to all laborers, workmen and mechanics performing their work under this contract.

The City of Madison reserves the right to waive, or not to waive, any irregularities in the bids and to reject any or all bids and to determine which is the lowest and best bid.

SUMMARY OF WORK

PART 1 - GENERAL

1.01 STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS

The following Special Provisions supplement the "Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction", Adopted April 1, 2016, the latest edition of the "Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways", and the "Manual of Test Procedures for Materials", in effect on the date of the invitation for bids; which apply to and govern the proposed improvements for the Industrial Site HMA Improvements in Madison, Illinois and in case of conflict with any part or parts of said specifications, these special provisions shall govern. In the event that no special provision is provided for an item of work, the Standard specifications shall govern.

1.02 DESCRIPTION OF WORK

The proposed work consists of sweeping the existing lot to remove loose debris and aggregate, filling potholes with HMA leveling binder, constructing a scratch coat surface level binder, and Hot-Mix Asphalt surface course overlay.

1.03 SITE INSPECTION

The Contractor shall be responsible for an on-site inspection prior to submitting a bid on this project. Upon receipt of a bid, it shall be assumed that the Contractor is fully familiar with the construction site.

1.04 JOINT UTILITY LOCATING INFORMATION FOR EXCAVATORS (JULIE)

This work shall be done in accordance with Article 107.37 of the Standard Specifications, except as herein modified.

Because a minimum of 48 hours' advance notice is required for notification to utilities, the Contractor will be required to give the Owner 96 hours' notice, in writing, for a specific area prior to beginning any excavation.

Locations of proposed drainage structures, storm sewers, pipe culverts, etc., shall be staked and then notice provided as above.

If any of the location markers placed by a utility company in conformance with this procedure are destroyed by Contractor operators, the Contractor shall immediately notify the utility owner and bear the cost of remarking the facilities at his own cost and expense. Compliance with this special provision shall be considered included in the contract and no additional compensation will be allowed for any cost incurred.

Compliance with this special provision shall be in accordance with Article 105.07 of the Standard Specifications, and no additional compensation or remuneration will be allowed
