

Madison City Council
Minutes
September 28, 2020

The City Council meeting was called to order by Mayor John Hamm at 6:00 p.m., followed by a request for roll call. Present were Alderpersons Jenkins, Bridick, Vrabec, Hampsey, Crochrell, Riskovsky, Haynes and Gardner. Absent: None.

All present recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

It was moved by Alderman Bridick, seconded by Alderman Haynes, to approve the minutes of the regular Council meeting held on September 14, 2020. Voice vote as follows: eight (8) ayes; no nays. Absent: None. Motion carried.

It was moved by Alderman Vrabec, seconded by Alderperson Bridick, to approve the presentation of the Comptroller's Report as submitted and that bills be allowed as drawn on the treasury and presented to the Council, unless there are any questions of the Summary of Expenses for the period of September 14, 2020 through September 28, 2020 in the amount of \$272,140.42. The Comptroller's Report was accepted as presented, to be placed on file. Roll call vote as follows: Ayes: Jenkins, Bridick, Vrabec, Hampsey, Crochrell, Riskovsky, Haynes and Gardner. Nays: None. Absent: None. Motion carried.

It was moved by Alderman Vrabec, seconded by Alderman Haynes, to approve the appointment of Johntay Henderson to Fire Cadet. Voice vote as follows: eight (8) ayes; no nays. Absent: None. Motion carried.

There were no members of the public wanting to address the Council.

Police Commissioner Donald Turner reported that applications are being taken for the position of Lateral Policeman at the Police Department. There being no other reports to come before the Council, it was moved by Alderman Haynes, seconded by Alderman Riskovsky, to accept the reports of Department Officers. Voice vote as follows: eight (8) ayes; no nays. Absent: None. Motion carried.

It was moved by alderman Riskovsky, seconded by Alderman Haynes, to approve the City having flu shots administered at the Fire Station on October 12, 2020. Voice vote as follows: eight (8) ayes; no nays. Absent: None. Motion carried.

It was moved by Alderman Hampsey, seconded by Alderman Vrabec, to approve the request from Karen Cooper to place property located at #5 Caine Drive up for surplus property Illinois American Water. Roll call vote as follows: Ayes: Jenkins, Bridick, Vrabec, Hampsey, Crochrell, Riskovsky, Haynes and Gardner. Nays: None. Absent: None. Motion carried.

It was moved by Alderman Hampsey, seconded by Alderman Vrabec, to approve the request from Issa Arar to place property located at 304-308 Madison Avenue up for surplus property for

commercial use. Roll call vote as follows: Ayes: Jenkins, Bridick, Vrabec, Hampsey, Crochrell, Riskovsky, Haynes and Gardner. Nays: None. Absent: None. Motion carried.

It was moved by Alderman Hampsey, seconded by Alderman Bridick, to approve Resolution #20-29 “A Resolution Authorizing the Sale/Disposal of Certain Real Property located at #5 Caine Drive.” Roll call vote as follows: Ayes: Jenkins, Bridick, Vrabec, Hampsey, Crochrell, Riskovsky, Haynes and Gardner. Nays: None. Absent: None. Motion carried.

It was moved by Alderman Hampsey, seconded by Alderman Bridick, to approve Resolution #20-30 “A Resolution Authorizing the Sale/Disposal of Certain Real Property located at 304-308 Madison Avenue.” Roll call vote as follows: Ayes: Jenkins, Bridick, Vrabec, Hampsey, Crochrell, Riskovsky, Haynes and Gardner. Nays: None. Absent: None. Motion carried.

It was moved by Alderman Hampsey, seconded by Alderman Bridick, to approve Resolution #20-31 “A Resolution of Adoption of the Madison County Multi-Jurisdictional all Hazards Mitigation Plan.” Roll call vote as follows: Ayes: Jenkins, Bridick, Vrabec, Hampsey, Crochrell, Riskovsky, Haynes and Gardner. Nays: None. Absent: None. Motion carried.

It was moved by Alderman Hampsey, seconded by Alderman Bridick, to suspend Rule 38 of Ordinance #549. Voice vote as follows: eight (8) ayes; no nays. Absent: None. Motion carried.

It was moved by Alderman Hampsey, seconded by Alderman Bridick, to approve Ordinance #1861, “An Ordinance Convening, Setting a date, time and place of meeting of the Joint Review Board.” Roll call vote as follows: Ayes: Jenkins, Bridick, Vrabec, Hampsey, Crochrell, Riskovsky, Haynes and Gardner. Nays: None. Absent: None. Motion carried.

It was moved by Alderman Hampsey, seconded by Alderman Bridick, to suspend Rule 38 of Ordinance #549. Voice vote as follows: eight (8) ayes; no nays. Absent: None. Motion carried.

It was moved by Alderman Hampsey, seconded by Alderman Bridick, to approve Ordinance #1862, “An Ordinance fixing a time and place for a Public Hearing concerning an amendment to the River’s Edge Redevelopment Project Area Redevelopment Plan.” Roll call vote as follows: Ayes: Jenkins, Bridick, Vrabec, Hampsey, Crochrell, Riskovsky, Haynes and Gardner. Nays: None. Absent: None. Motion carried.

It was moved by Alderman Bridick, seconded by Alderman Jenkins, to approve the request from Rivers of Waters Worship Center to host a three-day City Revival, October 6-8 starting at 6 p.m. nightly. Voice vote as follows: eight (8) ayes; no nays. Absent: None. Motion carried.

Mayor Hamm provided an update on #1 Caine Drive answering questions of the council as needed. He also provided an update on 304 Madison Avenue, which is included in the request

for surplus property from Issa Arar. Mayor also gave an update on houses to be demoed in the upcoming weeks.

After discussion, it was unanimously approved by the Council to allow Mayor Hamm to transfer his vehicle to the Fire Chief, who is in need of a new vehicle.

There was no miscellaneous business or Executive Session.

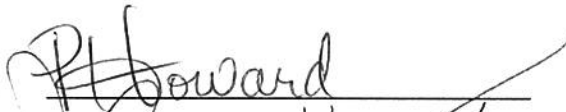
