

Madison City Council
Minutes
June 7, 2021

The City Council meeting was called to order by Mayor John Hamm at 6:00 p.m., Follow by request for roll call. Present were: Alderpersons Browley, Cochrell, Dixon, Hampsey, Haynes, Jenkins, Johnson and Vrabec Absent: none

All present recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

It was moved by Alderman Haynes, seconded by Alderman Hampsey, to approve the minutes of the regular Council meeting held on May 24, 2021. Voice vote as follows: Eight (8) ayes; no nays Absent: none Motion carried.

It was moved by Alderman Vrabec, seconded by Alderman Haynes, to approve the presentation of the Comptroller's Report as submitted and that bills be allowed as drawn on the treasury and presented to the Council, unless there are any questions of the Summary of Expenses for the period of May 21, 2021 through June 07, 2021 in the amount of \$313,721.25. The Comptroller's Report was accepted as presented, to be placed on file. Roll call as follows: Browley, Cochrell, Dixon, Hampsey, Haynes, Jenkins, Johnson and Vrabec. Motion carried.

It was moved by Alderman Haynes, seconded by Alderman Hampsey to accept the Letter of Resignation from Jeffrey S. Bridick as Police Chief of City of Madison Roll call vote as follows: Browley, Cochrell, Dixon, Hampsey, Haynes, Jenkins Johnson and Vrabec. Motion carried.

Member of Public ask the Mayor if there was going to be a replacement for the Chief of Police. Mayor response was Assistance Chief of Police Dennis Pinero is stepping in at this moment.

Building Inspector Buckles reported they are working on demolishing 8 peoples. 3 were ready for demo at the current time. They are almost ready for the other 5.

Police Commission Donald Turner reported they are looking for new Police Officer in the City of Madison. They have until June 21 to apply. There will be a mandatory training on June 26. This position has been posted on the website and all social media platforms.

It was moved to accept reports from department officer voice vote as follow Eight (8) ayes no nays. Absent none. Motion carried.

It was moved by Alderman Vrabec, seconded by Alderman Hampsey to approve the Intergovernmental Agreement between the City of Madison and The Department of Transportation pursuant to "Intergovernmental Cooperation Act". Roll call vote as follows: Browley, Cochrell, Dixon, Hampsey, Haynes, Jenkins Johnson and Vrabec. Motion carried.

It was moved by Alderwoman Johnson, seconded by Alderwoman Browley to approve the Proclamation By The Mayor to proclaim the Month of May as Motorcycle Awareness Month. Roll call vote as follows: Browley, Cochrell, Dixon, Hampsey, Haynes, Jenkins Johnson and Vrabec. Motion carried.

Mayor spoke about how tiny homes was built in 48hrs. The volunteers worked to get this completed. The veteran is all moved in. The next home will probably start getting built around the 3rd week of June.

There being no other business to come before the council, it was moved by Alderwoman Crochrell and, seconded by Alderwoman Browley to adjourned meeting at 6:17pm. Voice vote as follow Eight (8) ayes; No nays Absent: none Motion Carried.
