David from the Police Union spoke and stated that some of his Police Officers does not want to get vaccinated. They would prefer to have an option to complete weekly testing.

A questions was asked will the PBPA pay overtime in cases that someone not vaccinated gets Covid and they need Police Officers to cover the shift.

There was some lengthy discussions on the different options, suggestions and concerns.

Solution was to rescind the Vaccination Policy and have each department come up with a Covid Policy.

There was a motion on the floor to take recommendations to the upcoming City County meeting for September 27, 2021.
