

Madison City Council
Minutes
September 7, 2021

The City Council meeting was called to order by Mayor John Hamm at 6:00 p.m., Follow by request for roll call. Present were: Alderpersons Browley, Crochrell, Dixon, Hampsey, Haynes, Jenkins, Johnson and Vrabec Absent: none

All present recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

It was moved by Alderman Crochrell, seconded by Alderwoman Johnson, to approve the minutes of the regular Council meeting held on August 16, 2021. Voice vote as follows: six (8) ayes; no nays Absent: none. Motion carried.

It was moved by Alderman Vrabec, seconded by Alderman Hampsey, to approve the presentation of the Comptroller's Report as submitted and that bills be allowed as drawn on the treasury and presented to the Council, unless there are any questions of the Summary of Expenses for the period of August 16, 2021 through August 30, 2021 in the amount of \$3195,026.35. The Comptroller's Report was accepted as presented, to be placed on file. Roll call as follows: Browley, Crochrell, Dixon, Hampsey, Haynes, Jenkins, Johnson and Vrabec. Motion carried.

Department Offices Report:

Police Chief discuss that the Police Department is starting up a problem control patrolling area for the police officer to set up. They did a test run and set up in an area and they had 11 traffic stops with 18 citations handed out. He is surveying the area and will start placing officer in problematic areas in regards to traffic. He will attempt to look for a spot in each Ward.

Police Chief mention that the background check was completed for all 4 candidates. They will move on to the next step.

Fire Chief provided a written report.

It was moved by Alderman Hampsey and seconded by Alderman Vrabec to approve Ordinance Annexing Contiguous, Uninhabited and Unincorporated Territory in Madison County Illinois by the city of Madison. Roll call vote as follows: Browley, Cochrell, Dixon, Hampsey, Haynes, Jenkins Johnson and Vrabec. Motion carried.

It was moved by Alderman Hampsey and seconded by Alderwoman Dixon to approve "Resolution for Maintenance Under the Illinois Highway Code in the amount of \$27,500.00" Roll call vote as follows: Browley, Cochrell, Dixon, Hampsey, Haynes, Jenkins Johnson and Vrabec. Motion carried.




