

Madison City Council
Minutes
May 10, 2021

The City Council meeting was called to order by Mayor John Hamm at 6:15 p.m., Follow by request for roll call. Present were: Alderpersons Jenkins, Browley, Vrabec, Hampsey, Crochrell Johnson, Haynes and Dixon Absent: None

It was moved by Alderman Vrabec, seconded by Alderman Hampsey, to accept letter of resignation from Nicholas Gailius as Police Chief. Voice vote as follows: eight (8) ayes; no nays Absent: none. Motion carried.

It was moved by Alderman Vrabec, seconded by Alderman Cochrell , to approve to accept the letter of resignation from Jeffrey Briddick as Alderman for Ward 1. Roll call as follows: Browley, Vrabec, Hampsey, Crochrell, Johnson, Haynes and Dixon Motion carried.

Motion to Appoint replacement for Alderman of Ward 1. Mayor nominates Dreetta Jenkins It was moved by Alderman Hampsey, seconded by Alderman Hayne. Roll Call as follows: Hampsey, Haynes and Vrabec all ayes. Browley, Crochrell and Dixon all nays, Johnson, abstain. Mayor breaks tie and appoints Dreetta Jenkins as Alderwoman of Ward 1. Motion carried.

Dreetta Jenkins sworn in by Mayor.

It was moved by Alderman Vrabec, seconded by Alderman Hampsey to approve 2021 Appointments. Roll call vote as follows: Jenkins, Vrabec, Hampsey, Crochrell, Dixon, Haynes, Johnson, Browley. Motion carried.

Jeffrey Briddick sworn in as Police Chief by Mayor
Lieutenant Dennis Pinero sworn in as Asst. Police Chief by Mayor

Appointment for Alderman Committee by Mayor was submitted.

It was moved by Alderman Vrabec, seconded by Crochwell to approve recommendation from the Board of Police Commissioners to Promote Sergeant J.D. Harris to the rank of Lieutenant. Roll call vote as follows: Jenkins, Browley, Vrabec, Hampsey, Crochrell, Johnson, Haynes and Dixon. Motion carried.

Sergeant J.D. Harris sworn in as Lieutenant.

It was moved by Alderman Hampsey, seconded by Alderman Vrabec to suspend Rule 38 of Ordinance #549. Voice vote as follows: Eight (8) ayes no nays. Absent none. Motion carried.

It was moved by Alderman Vrabec seconded by Alderman Hampsey to approve "An Ordinance Further Amending Ordinance, 1767 to Amend Territory & Expand the Southwestern Madison County Enterprise Zone" Ordinance 1870 Roll call vote as follows: Jenkins, Browley, Vrabec, Hampsey, Crochrell, Johnson, Haynes and Dixon. Motion Carried.

It was moved by Alderman Vrabec and seconded by Alderman Hampsey to "An Amendment to the Intergovernmental Agreement Between the County of Madison, City of Granite City, City of Venice, and the City of Madison for the Southwestern Madison County Enterprise Zone". Roll call vote as follows: Jenkins, Browley, Vrabec, Hampsey, Crochrell, Johnson, Haynes and Dixon. Motion Carried

It was moved by Alderman Hampsey and seconded by Alderman Haynes to approve Mayor signing "Part F Applicant Certification" pertaining to the above actions taken with respect to the Southwestern Madison County Enterprise Zone. Roll call as follow Jenkins, Browley, Vrabec, Hampsey, Crochrell, Johnson, Haynes and Dixon. Voice Motion Carried.

It was moved by Alderman Haynes and second by Alderman Crochrell to approve request from Doris Harrell-Williams pres. of Sister to Sister Outreach Ministry to use the city lot at 3rd Street & Madison Avenue for "Holy Ghost Block Party" on May 31, 2021 from 2pm till 8pm. Roll call vote as follows: Jenkins, Browley, Vrabec, Hampsey, Crochrell, Johnson, Haynes and Dixon. Motion Carried

It was moved by Alderman Vrabec and seconded by Alderwoman Jenkins to move forward with Waste Management Annexation. Roll call as follow: Jenkins, Browley, Vrabec, Hampsey, Crochrell, Johnson, Haynes and Dixon. Motion Carried.

It was moved by Alderman Haynes and seconded by Alderman Jenkins to hire Jaime Henderson for architectural plans for Rec. Center improvements to ADA compliance including kitchen and bathrooms. Voice vote as follows: Eight (8) ayes. No nays. Motion Carried.
