Minutes  
April 12, 2021

The City Council meeting was called to order by Mayor John Hamm at 6:00 p.m., Follow by request for roll call. Present were: Alderpersons Jenkins, Bridick, Vrabec, Hampsey, Crochrell Riskovsky, Haynes and Gardner Absent: None

All present recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

It was moved by Alderman Bridick, seconded by Alderman Vrabec, to approve the minutes of the regular Council meeting held on March 29, 2021. Voice vote as follows: eight (8) ayes; no nays Absent: none. Motion carried.

It was moved by Alderman Vrabec, seconded by Alderman Bridick, to approve the presentation of the Comptroller's Report as submitted and that bills be allowed as drawn on the treasury and presented to the Council, unless there are any questions of the Summary of Expenses for the period of March 29, 2021 through April 12, 2021 in the amount of \$199572.00 The Comptroller's Report was accepted as presented, to be placed on file. It was moved by Alderman Bridick and seconded by Alderman Vrabc to allow Mayor to sign application for the SWIDA funds that 360 Group is applying for \$1 million to help people buying new homes in Madison. Roll call vote as follows: Jenkins, Bridick, Vrabc, Hampsey, Crochrell, Riskovsky, Haynes and Gardner. Motion Carried.




