



Permit Fee Schedule

- A.** In addition to the following fees, all fees and costs for professional expertise needed by the city to perform inspections on its behalf shall be added to and included in such fees
- B.** Construction, alterations, additions, repair or maintenance of buildings and structures (to include Solar):
- a.** Single-family and multi-family residential structures and accessory structures
 - i.** Less than \$1,000 \$30
 - ii.** \$1,000 or more \$60 plus \$5/1,000
 - b.** Commercial and Industrial \$115/1st \$10,000 plus \$5/1,000 over 10,000
 - c.** Decks and accessory building \$50 (including non-residential)
 - d.** Fence Permit \$55
 - e.** Boilers \$50
 - f.** Mechanical (heating & cooling) \$75
 - i.** Additional inspection fee \$25
 - g.** Residential Roof Permit \$60
 - h.** Commercial Roof Permit \$100
- C.** Razing Permit (building/structure removal) \$ 75
- D.** Excavation/locating (dig permit) \$30
- E.** Plumbing Inspection See Plumbing Code
- F.** Electrical Inspection (for service only) \$45 plus \$15/100 additional amps service
- a.** After 2nd fail inspection \$40
- G.** Sewer line tap-on/sewage disposal system \$200
- H.** Lateral inspection fee
- I.** Temporary utility/work permit \$60
- J.** Dumpster Rental
- a.** 20 yard \$275
 - b.** 30 yard \$300
- K.** Certificate of Occupancy
- a.** Residential – Initial \$60
 - i.** After 2nd fail \$35
 - b.** Commercial -Initial \$125
 - i.** After 2nd fail \$60
 - c.** Pre-Inspection \$100
- L.** Swimming Pools \$75
(including electrical inspection and certificate of occupancy)

There shall be no refunds on permits once application is filed with the city.
