Health Committee Meeting May 22, 2023 @ 5:30 Minutes

Alderperson Browley Chair of the Health Committee called the meeting to order @ 5:30 p.m.

Resident Mr. Carr made a presentation about the chickens and their types of homes. Mr. Carr said that most homes run around 300.00 or under and they will house about 4 chickens.

Alderperson Miller asked how do the neighbors feel about this?

Mr. Carr responded that he has not spoken to the neighbors in regards to the chickens.

Alderperson Crawford asked How did this all come about? Mayor Hamm informed the newly seated alderpeople that Mr. Carr came to the council and asked that the ordinance regarding chickens be changed. Alderperson Crochrell added this is only for chickens that lay eggs.

The question was asked what if they get out? Mr. Carr advised there is a State Law about chicken roaming free. There is a concern about the chickens getting out and the fee associated with this.

It was decided by the council to refer this to Derek Filcoff to come up with an ordinance for the chickens with these provisions.

First time set up fee will \$100.00 and yearly fee will be \$30.00

Enclosure must be mobile for cleaning purposes.

Chickens must be kept in the enclosure at all times.

No slaughter or selling of eggs.
