Minutes
April 21, 2025

The City Council meeting was called to order by Mayor Hamm at 6:00 p.m.

All present recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

Follow by request for roll call. Present were Alderperson Browley, Dixon, Crochrell, Garrett, Johnson, Morris and Miller Absent: Crawford

It was moved by Alderperson Miller, seconded by Alderperson Morris, to approve the minutes of the regular Council meeting held on April 7, 2025. Voice vote as follows: Seven (7) ayes; no nays Absent: Crawford Motion Carried

It was moved by Alderperson Morris, seconded by Alderperson Browley, to approve the presentation of the Comptroller's Report as submitted and that bills be allowed as drawn on the treasury and presented to the Council, unless there are any questions of the Summary of Expenses for the period of April 9, 2025, through April 21, 2025, in the amount of \$153,942.12.
